Preface

We are so excited to partner with the Farmington Valley Symphony Orchestra in this special concert, celebrating the 10th anniversary of their music director, Jonathan Colby. In the first half, the orchestra will perform *Symphony No. 3 in C minor, Op. 78*, by Camille Saint-Saëns. It is popularly known as the "Organ Symphony", since, unusually for a late-Romantic symphony, two of the four sections use the pipe organ. The composer inscribed it as: Symphonie No. 3 "avec orgue". The second half continues with the orchestra performing *Fanfare for the Uncommon Woman, No 3*, by Joan Tower. The Chorale then joins the orchestra for Antonín Dvořák's spectacular *Te Deum, Op. 103*. Written in 1892, just a few months before moving to America, this 20-minute piece served as an introduction of his music to American audiences.

Editing of scores:

Vocal assignments for chorus:

Everyone is assigned either as I/II (higher/lower within the section) as well as à3 (high/middle/low). These divisi make possible the covering of adjacent vocal lines for balance, heft, or clarity. For now, everyone sing within your own part, and divide accordingly. However, please be ready for any adjustments that may occur in rehearsal.
